NIKOLA TESLA – FORGOTTEN GENIUS

Historian Tom Keller presented this intriguing program on the history of the inventor who was a mechanical and electrical engineer. Tesla was best known for his many revolutionary developments in the field of electromagnetism in the late 19th and early 20th centuries. Tesla's patents and theoretical work formed the basis of modern alternating current (AC) electric power systems, including the polyphase system of electrical distribution and the AC motor helping to usher in the Second Industrial Revolution.

Aside from his work on electromagnetism and electromechanical engineering, Tesla contributed in varying degrees to the establishment of robotics, remote control, radar and computer science as well as to the expansion of ballistics, nuclear physics and theoretical physics.

Among other fascinating projects, Tesla was involved in the death ray, electric airplanes, moon rover, atomic bomb, and the possibly unreal "Philadelphia Experiment" during which FDR donated the USS Eldridge to be used as a target for a death ray.
