HUBBLE SPACE TELESCOPE PROGRAM!

EVERY SINGLE SEAT (and then some) was filled for this great program with insider views of the latest space shuttle launch and 2010 updates. Kristi Martinez first spoke to our Kiwanis club at age 12. She has been with Ball Aerospace & Technology Corporation for 15 years and is always delighted to talk to Kiwanians because we "get it". As a group, we look beyond ourselves to the future.

The Hubble Space Telescope has been performing for 20 years now and amazingly, is in the best shape ever. The last mission fixed and replaced and recycled optics, gyroscopes and more.

Every 96 minutes, it orbits the earth and you can watch it from your own backyard!! Go to heavens-above.com and put in your address and the site will tell you exactly when the Hubble (and the Space Station) will fly right over your house!

Every book on astronomy is already outdated thanks to discoveries made by the Hubble. It will take decades to compile all the data received from this marvelous telescope. Children who are interested in astronomy can still find unknown planets and possibly locate the farthest reaches of the universe when they are adults. beSpace Telescope is scheduled to be launched by the Ariane 5 rocket in June 2014 for a 5-year mission searching for light from the first stars and galaxies formed after the Big Bang. Kirsten Martinez, from Ball Laboratories, brings this fascinating program to us. Don't miss it!!
